## Hey there, how are you? Here's an Old Church Update

Welcome to our March newsletter update! As we transition from winter to spring, we're excited to share the latest developments and happenings within our community. So, grab a cup of your favorite beverage, settle in, and let's dive into what's been happening!

As mentioned in our membership info email, we briefly addressed the necessity of adjusting dues to accommodate rising operational costs. However, we recognize the importance of providing further clarity on this matter and explaining how your input directly impacts our operations.

Despite our concerted efforts to control expenses, we anticipate facing a significant deficit of \$20,000 based on our projected expenses for pool management and maintenance, insurance, and utilities this 2024 season. This shortfall is primarily due to rising operational costs and remains even if our membership stays steady at 140 families.

Your help and support is integral in helping us overcome this challenge. Please see page 2 for ways to help, remember this center relies on the kindness and support of its community.

Recent happenings include Ellis Tree Service's preventative tree and limb removal. By removing these potentially dangerous limbs, we've taken a proactive step towards safeguarding the well-being of our members and guests. Douglas Aquatics initiated the initial dewinterizing processes as the month drew to a close.
